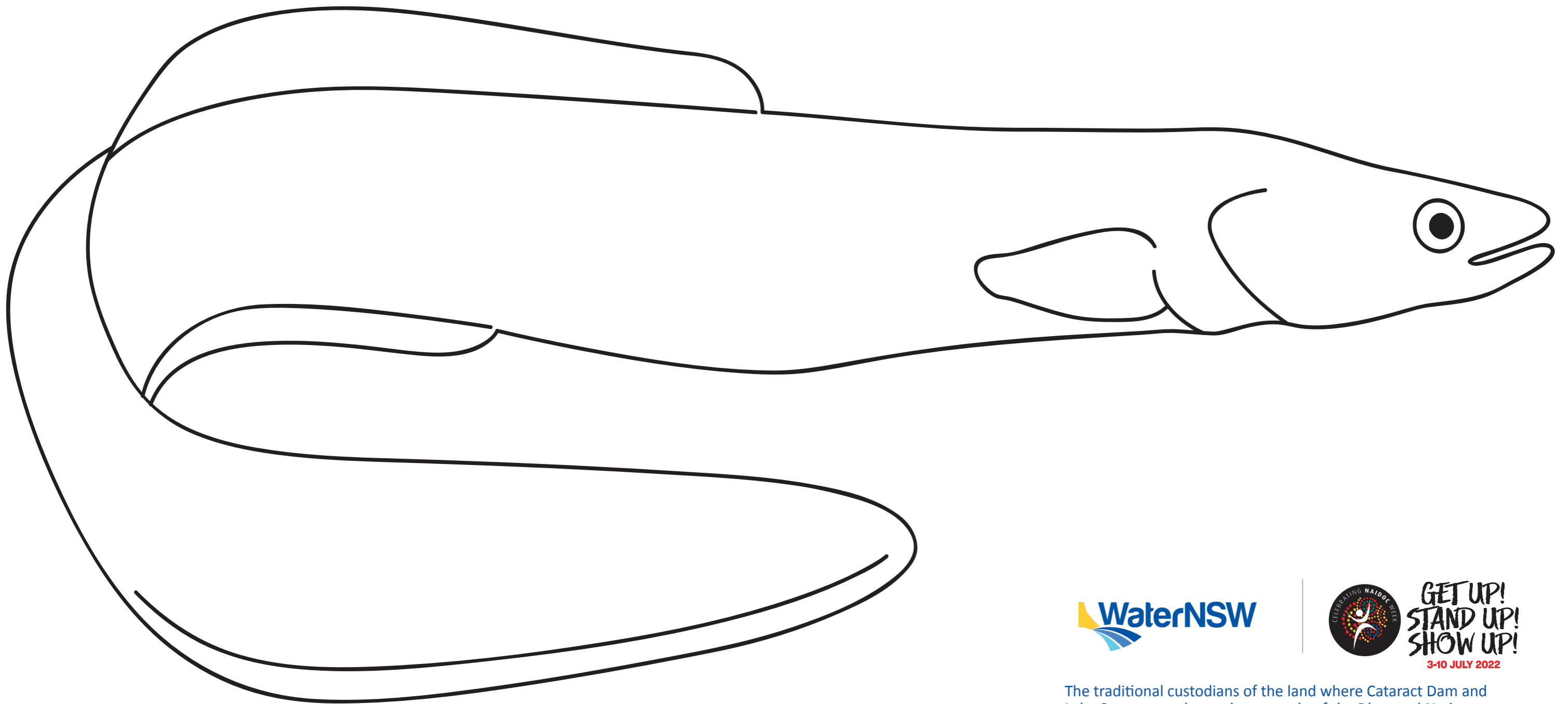


Long-finned eel
